







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COVID-19 Vaccine Update

The New Bi-Valent mRNA COVID-19 Vaccines by Moderna and Pfizer have been show to be effective in preventing severe disease, hospitalization and death, and in limiting infections from current circulating strains.

The FDA advisory committee has recommended the vaccine schedule be switched so that all mRNA vaccinations are of this type.

The CDC advisory committee meets later this month and is expected to adopt the same recommendation. They may also lay out a preliminary vaccine booster schedule that more closely follows seasonal influenza schedules.

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Federal Public Emergency Declaration Ending in May

What does this mean:

The Federal Government is recognizing that ongoing efforts to combat the spread and consequences of COVID-19 infections can be managed at the State and Local levels.

Federal supplemental funding will most likely cease for testing, vaccinations, and treatment for COVID-19.

Federal Assistance Programs to businesses and healthcare coverage expansion (ex: Medicaid) will most likely cease or be greatly curtailed.

Certain Federal protection for insurance coverage will most likely cease or be rolled back in some way (ex: co-pay suspensions)

This does not mean the pandemic is over and that Federal, State, and Local measures to protect workers and the general population immediately cease.

COVID-19 Vaccination and Booster Eligibility Updates

Booster dose appointments for Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccines are now available for people 18 and over who meet criteria.

People 5 years or older are currently eligible to schedule a COVID-19 vaccination.

Important:

- Community members under age 18 who would like to be vaccinated, must have a parent or guardian complete and initial the online scheduling form
 on their behalf.
- In addition to scheduling a vaccine using the online process, patients under 18 are be required to bring a completed consent to treat form signed by their parent or guardian to their appointment.
- Patients under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to their vaccination.

- If you cannot find an appointment that works for you at a Northern Light Health location, please visit the state COVID-19 vaccination sites list.
- Please print your appointment confirmation and bring it with you. Vaccination candidates will receive an email confirming their vaccination location


